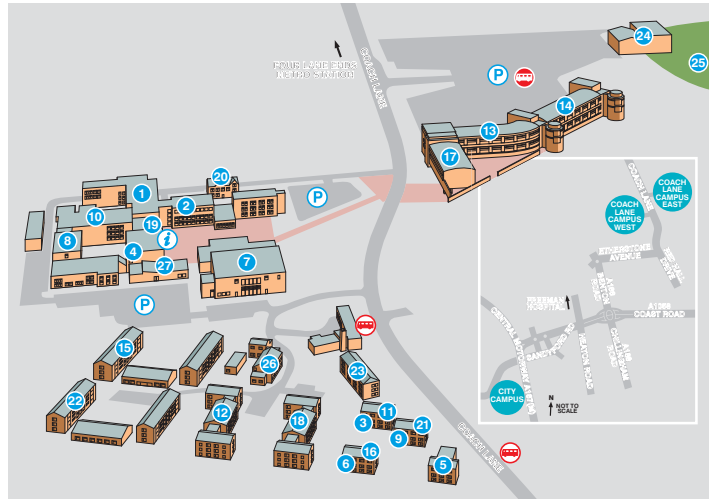

Coach Lane Campus is located three miles north east of Newcastle city centre. If you are travelling by car from the city centre (City Campus) follow the A167(M) north before turning right onto the A1058 (Jesmond Road). After around one mile, turn left at the roundabout along the A188 (Benton Road) and turn right at the next roundabout along Etherstone Avenue. Follow this road until you come to a junction, turn left and you will shortly come to the campus on Coach Lane.

HOW TO GET TO NORTHUMBRIA

ROAD

The region is particularly well served by the A1(M) from London in the south and Edinburgh in the north, the A19 from York, the A69 from Carlisle and the M6 from the south west and west.

Parking at the City Campus is restricted, but you may use one of the many public car parks within walking distance (see city map opposite). There is ample cycle parking on both our campuses.

RAIL

Direct services operate from many cities to Newcastle's Central Station including the high speed service linking London, Newcastle and Edinburgh.

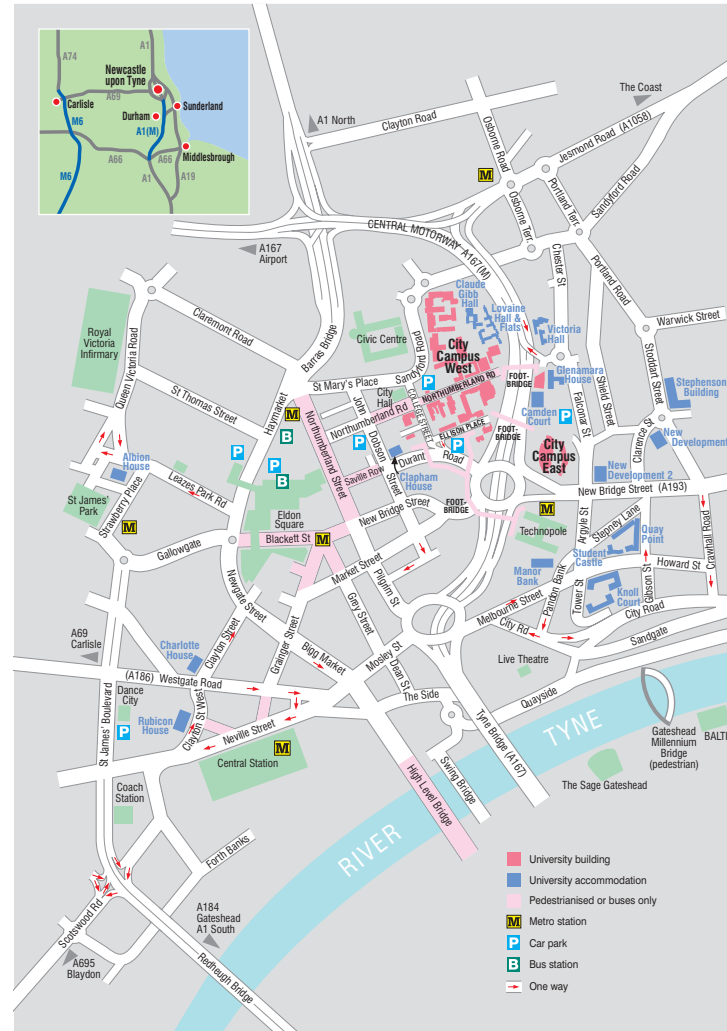
METRO
