Star Student (Year 8)

November 2011 – February 2012 (Every Wednesday and Friday)

A giant board game that subtly introduces the concept of Higher Education using interactive team challenges. Delivered in schools by two current undergraduate students, the game covers topics ranging from finance to university social life.

HE Unravalled (For people aged 19+)

1 – 3 November 2011

Explore the different aspects of going to university, from how to apply, to life as a student.

9 November 2011

An opportunity for prospective postgraduate students to find out more about the courses, facilities and services available at Northumbria University.

Evolve @ Northumbria (1st year college students)

21 – 25 November 2011

An informal conference aimed at introducing college students to the different aspects of university life, helping them prepare for the transition between Further and Higher Education.
