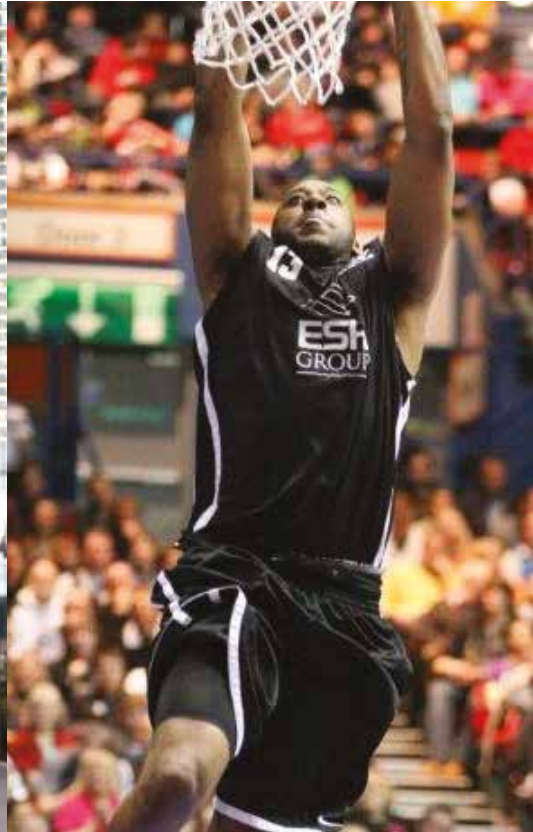

We accept applications through UCAS, Common App or directly on our website.

Undergraduate:

- Advanced level with six grade 12 courses

Postgraduate:

- B/3.0/73% on courses requiring a UK 2:2 equivalent
- B+/3.3/77% on courses requiring a UK 2:1 equivalent

Fees and Living Costs

£5,000 - Study Abroad per semester

Living Costs: £1,015 per month minimum
