Early Payment Discounts

- You will qualify for an early payment discount of **£300** if you pay your full tuition fee for the academic year in advance and meet all of the following conditions:
- The tuition fee in your offer letter is more than £8000 and you **pay your deposit** three months before the start of the programme
 - You are a self-funding student starting an academic degree or diploma programme which lasts at least one full academic year
 - You have already received an offer prior to payment

English Language Requirements

The University offers a variety of English Language courses for those students preparing to study on a full-time academic programme.
