Early Payment Discounts

You will qualify for an early payment discount of £300 if you pay your full tuition fee for the academic year in advance and meet all of the following conditions:

- You have already received an offer prior to payment
- The tuition fee in your offer letter is more than £8,000
- You are a self-funding student starting an academic degree or diploma programme which lasts at least one full academic year

If you meet these conditions please note that the deduction will be taken from your final payment and not from your deposit.

Students will receive the deduction where the deposit is received on or before:

- 1 July* - for September intake**
- 1 November* - for January intake**

English Language Requirements

The University offers a variety of English Language courses for those students preparing to study on a full-time academic programme.
